Distinctive Courses in this Major

POLS 3301 Research Methods in Political Science 3hrs

An introduction to the quantitative and qualitative techniques for measurement, analysis, and inference of political data.

POLS 3601 African American Politics 3hrs

An examination of black political movements, participation of African American in the American political system, particularly the electoral process, the power structure in African American communities.

POLS 4201 Political Theory 3hrs

An examination of the theoretical approaches to the basic political concepts in their historical context.

POLS 4901 Senior Seminar 3hrs

An examination of selected topics in political science. Open only to senior majors.
